- Students must prepare **ready-to-paste** items. These should be lightweight and easily attachable to flannel boards.
- **Photographs or portraits** of: Famous authors and writers, Renowned poets and literary figures
- Writer's name, Birth–death years, Major contributions, Achievements- Written in clean **calligraphic letters**
- Print or draw the covers of the authors' most famous books.
- Borders to frame the flannel board
- Handmade patterns, traditional motifs, designs symbolising language heritage
- **Language prosperity elements:** Alphabets or letter art, Word clouds,
- Vocabulary flowers, Literary symbols, Any creative item that reflects richness of language
- Students must bring their materials to school on the assigned date.
- All items should be labelled with the student's **name, class, and division**.
- Students will work in groups to arrange and decorate the flannel boards during the activity period.

Waste threads, wool, lace pieces, Paper scraps, leftover craft paper, Old greeting cards, Broken toys or unused accessories, Avoid buying new materials. Focus on recycling and reusing.
