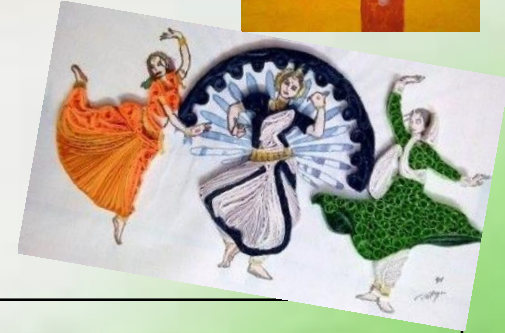

5. For collage work, students may use **newspaper cuttings, coloured paper, magazine pieces, fabric bits, leaves, pulses, or eco-friendly materials**.
6. Students must **bring all required materials from home**. Scissors should be used carefully.
7. The poster/collage must be **neat, clean, and well-arranged**.
8. The **student's name, class, and division** should be written clearly on the **back side** of the sheet.
9. Maintain **discipline and cleanliness** in the classroom during the activity.

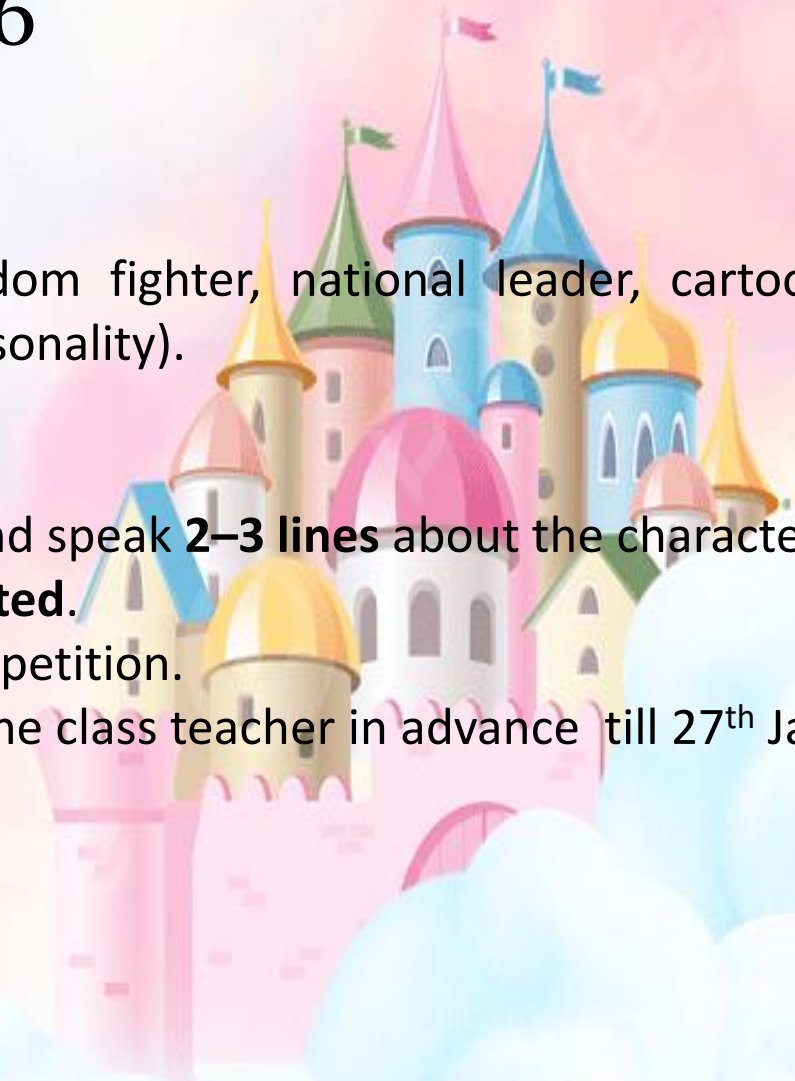

## Instructions for Students

3. **No hazardous, sharp, or heavy accessories** are allowed.
4. Each participant will be given **30–45 seconds** to introduce themselves and speak **2–3 lines** about the character.
5. Students should **memorize their lines**; reading from paper is **not permitted**.
6. School **discipline and decorum** must be maintained throughout the competition.
7. The **student's name, class, and character name** should be informed to the class teacher in advance till 27<sup>th</sup> Jan 2026

# Mime Competition(Solo)



## • Instructions for Students

- The competition is **solo**; group performances are not allowed.
- Mime is a **silent art form**; use of **dialogues, lip movements, written cards, or voice** is strictly prohibited.
- **Background music or sound effects are not permitted** unless informed separately.
- Participants must choose a **clear theme/message** such as social awareness, discipline, environmental protection, daily life situations, or patriotism.
- **Time limit:** *2 minutes per participant* (strictly followed).
- Costumes, make-up, and props, if used, should be **simple, safe, and relevant** to the act.
- Maintain **proper posture, expressions, and discipline** throughout the performance.
- The **judges' decision will be final and binding**.
