• **Preparation Tips**

• Revise your English vocabulary and pay special attention to commonly misspelled words.

• Practice spelling unfamiliar words aloud.

• Familiarize yourself with the meanings and usage of words.

• **Competition Rules**

• For the oral round, each participant will be given a word to spell within 15 seconds.

• You may ask the following:

• Repeat the word, Use it in a sentence, Provide the meaning

• Incorrect spelling or exceeding the time limit will result in elimination.
